Effective 1 July 1963, a new satellite joins the galaxy of alphabetized central offices within the Hawaii ANG: "CBPO".

Personnel administration functions of all HANG units will be centralized in a CONSOLIDATED BASE PERSONNEL OFFICE. new office, which will provide personnel services now performed by separate P & A sections within each HANG unit, will be located in the Group Headquarters Building in rooms now used by ABRON, CAMRON, and the Director of Operations.

Under the new concept, HANG CEPO will provide central field personnel records functions, will be the sole Special Order and Reserve Order issuing agency for the HANG, will be responsible for all appointing and enlisting functions for Oahu HANG units, and will furnish other personnel support to HANG units.

Major James K. Lota, Group Director of Personnel, will head the new office as Chief, HANG CBPO. Most of the personnel to be assigned to HANG CBPO will be from the Group's P & A Section, supplemented by personnel from Hq. HANG, 109th ACWRON, 150th ACWRON, and 169th ACWRON.
