NEW AUTOMATED TIME ATTENDANCE AND PRODUCTION SYSTEM (ATAAPS) PROCEDURES FOR PHYSICAL FITNESS

1. Reference.

National Guard Bureau Technician Branch Memorandum dated 28 November 2018, Subject: Administrative Leave Time Card Codes for Physical Fitness

- **2. Applicability**. National Guard T32 dual status technicians, National Guard T5 employees
- **3.** In accordance with 5 U.S.C. 7901, Health Services Program" and NGB-J1-TN Memorandum dated 29 June 2017, Criitcal Update to Assignment of Military Training Duties to Title 32 National Guard Technicians, National Guard Title 32 dual status technicians and Title 5 employees may be authorized excused absence of short durations to participate in voluntary Physical Fitness Program (PFPs). Dual Status technicians cannot be required to undergo an annual military physical fitness test while in technician status, either voluntary or involuntary.
- **4**. Effective immediately, all dual status technicians and Title 5 employees approved for the Hawaii National Guard Voluntary Physical Fitness Program will code their time card(s) in the Automated Time Attendance and Production System, (ATAAPS), as "LN" for administrative leave with an additional Hazardous/Other code of "PF" when participating in the HING Voluntary Physical Fitness Program.
